

Is ceoltóir, scríbhneoir amhrán, taibheoir, ealaiontóir taifeadta, scéalai, file agus aislingeach é John Spillane. Tá a chuid ceoil fréamhaithe i ndaoine, in áit agus i scéal, agus iompraíonn sé an t-éisteoir leis, agus meallann a chuid léirithe beo lucht féachana ar fud an domhain. Mar ealaiontóir, téann a chuid ceoil i bhfeidhm ar éisteoiri thar iliomad seánraí agus glúnta.
